## This Week at St. Andrew Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at 10:00 a.m. Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Join one next week!

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in Adult #2 in the Education wing of the church at 10:00 a.m. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives.

**Young Families Class...** This class is for married couples in their 30's and 40's with children. They discuss everyday life issues, family finances, various topics of interest to the group. Anyone interested in these topics related to our faith is invited to the Adult #3 classroom at 10:00 a.m. for the class.

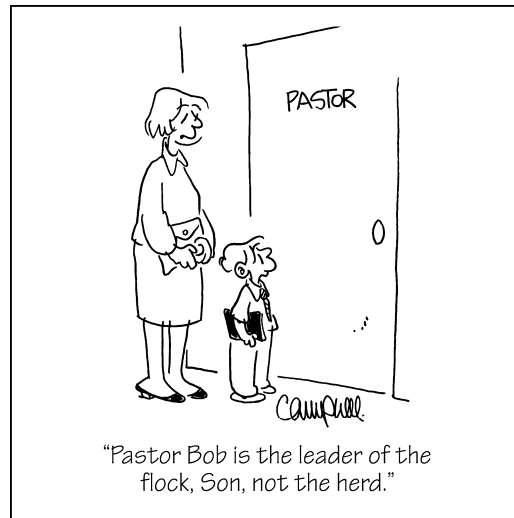
