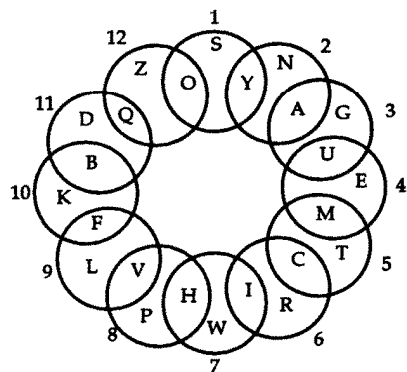

## Listening to Women's Voices

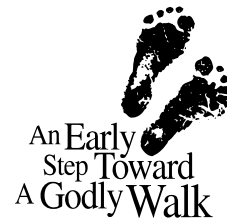
