The Last Road Trip

Pastors Pat and Tim are preaching throughout Lent on Jesus' last journey on the road to Jerusalem. The gospel of Luke takes a decided shift in chapter 9, verse 51 in which it says, "When the days drew near for him to be taken up, Jesus set his face to go to Jerusalem." And really from that point on Jesus begins his final journey not just to the great city of Jerusalem, but also to the cross, the grave, and from the empty tomb to the road to Emmaus.

Join us as our pastors help us find insight and inspiration in the final journey of Jesus, which nicely parallels our journey through the holy season of Lent.

If you are just checking us out this morning, then know, as our guest, that you are not obligated to put anything in the offering plate as it comes around.

Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

Know and Grow...This class is doing a seven-week Lenten study. This study examines Christ's last hours and final words at the cross in Adam Hamilton's *Final Words from the Cross*. They meet in **Adult Classroom 1**.

Christian Issues...This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. Today, the lesson will be on *Extreme Weather and Climate Change*.

Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...Starting today, this class will do a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. The focus will be on his missionary journeys, his writings, his establishment of the early church, and the theological foundation he provided for our Christian life today. There will be a discussion of the books written by Paul as well as those New Testament books associated with Paul's ministry and the writings of his followers. This series will explore the geography of Paul's missionary journeys, offer insights on the political scene, review the socio-economic conditions, explore the formation of the early churches, examine the theological debates, and study Paul's interpretation of the gospel message and ministry of Jesus Christ. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**.
