## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

**Know and Grow...** This class is doing a seven-week Lenten study. This study examines Christ's last hours and final words at the cross in Adam Hamilton's *Final Words from the Cross*. They meet in **Adult Classroom 1**.

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. Today, the lesson will be on *The Resignation of Pope Benedict XVI*. Pope Benedict XVI recently announced his resignation. What are the implications of this change for the Roman Catholic Church, for Christianity, and for the world?

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul.
