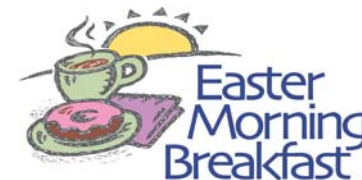
Softball Anyone?
