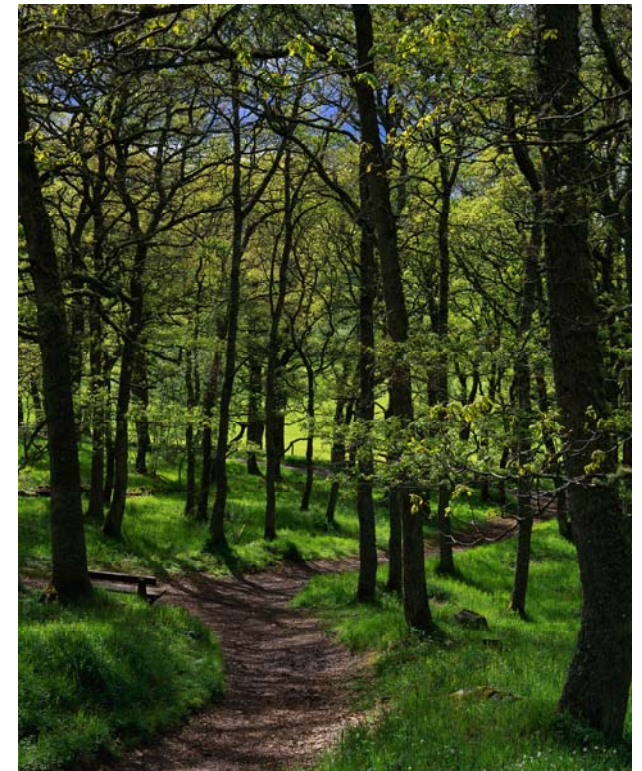
Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

Know and Grow... This class is doing a seven-week Lenten study. This study examines Christ's last hours and final words at the cross in Adam Hamilton's *Final Words from the Cross*. They meet in **Adult Classroom 1**.

Christian Issues... This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. Today, the lesson will be on *Drug Abuse*. Drug abuse affects the lives of people in rural and urban communities all across our nation. What are the hazards of abusing drugs? What can local churches do to help communities, families, and individuals whose lives are affected by this problem?

Biblical Foundations of Our Faith... This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**. **Please note that Marshall Martin, who teaches this class, will be out of state on Purdue business today so the class will not meet, but will resume on March 24.**
