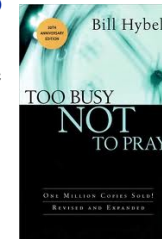

Please note that the church office will be closed the Monday after Easter, April 1.

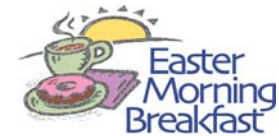
Too Busy Not to Pray!
