#### **Sunday School Classes**

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m**. Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:
