Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

Know and Grow... Beginning April 14, the Know and Grow class will begin a 12-week study of the book of Romans. This letter, written by Paul differs from all of his others. We will discuss how this is different. The class will also spend time reading and discussing the many important messages found in Romans. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available in the classroom.

Christian Issues... This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. Today, the lesson will be on *Loss and Change in Rural America*. The most recent US Census shows a dramatic population decline in rural areas, particularly in the Great Plains. What impact does this population change have on these communities? What challenges do these conditions pose for churches as they seek to proclaim a message of hope?

Biblical Foundations of Our Faith... This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**.
