

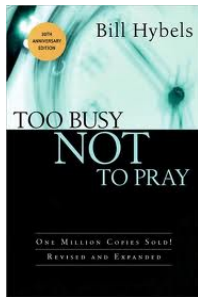
Rejuvenate Sunday Coming

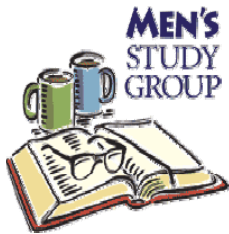


White Rose on the Communion Table
