### Bad Calls From the Bible

We are wrapping up our sermon series following the theme of *Bad Calls from the Bible*. This series focused on great women and men from the Bible and the bad calls, or poor decisions, that they made as well as how we can learn to avoid those same kind of mistakes in our own lives.

Some heroes of the faith made binding vows and promises that they soon regretted; others made rash decisions on God's behalf without first consulting God; and there were still others who allowed anger, jealousy, and impulsiveness to cloud their better judgment. The St. Andrew pastors went deep into the scriptures to retell some of the important stories that we may have overlooked in our daily devotions. They also pointed out some of the well-known contemporary people who have fallen into the same trap, and spent some time figuring out how to protect us and our loved ones from making those same 'bad calls'.

If you are just checking us out this morning, then know, as our guest, that you are not obligated to put anything in the offering plate as it comes around.

## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at 10:00 a.m. Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes include:

**Know and Grow...** This class will begin a 12-week study of the book of Romans. This letter, written by Paul differs from all of his others. We will discuss how this is different. **Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives.

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**. Marshall Martin has international travel on May 5, 12, and 19. The class will resume when he returns from Argentina and continue throughout the summer.

**Fresh Faith...** How do you handle your most stressful days? Is your first thought to ask God for help? How about on your best days? Do you share your joy with God? Prayer is the focus of this **Fresh Faith** class. We are going to read and discuss the classic, *Too Busy Not to Pray* by Bill Hybels. Books will be provided at the first session. Hope you aren't too busy to join us in the **Intersection**.
