## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

**Know and Grow...** This class is studying the book of Romans. This letter, written by Paul differs from all of his others. We will discuss how this is different. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available.

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. This week the topic is *Struggles for Men*.

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**. Marshall Martin has international travel on May 5, 12, and 19. The class will resume on May 26 when he returns from Argentina and continue throughout the summer.

**Fresh Faith...** How do you handle your most stressful days? Is your first thought to ask God for help? How about on your best days? Do you share your joy with God? Prayer is the focus of this **Fresh Faith** class. We are going to read and discuss the classic, *Too Busy Not to Pray* by Bill Hybels. Books will be provided at the first session. Hope you aren't too busy to join us in the **Intersection**.
