**Date:** Sunday, June 2

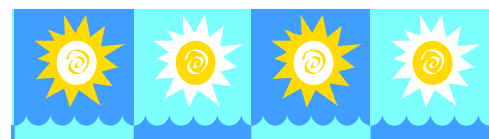
**Time:** 6:00 - 7:30 p.m.
