## Following the Recipe

Pentecost has been described as the birthday of the church. In reality, Pentecost is more like the baptism of the church. The church began when Jesus called 12 disciples and poured his teaching and time into their lives and set them loose on the world. The church had been gathered together in Jerusalem, praying and waiting for a sign. On the Hebrew holy day of Pentecost the sign came in the form of tongues of flame and the rush of wind. ## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

**Know and Grow...** This class is studying the book of Romans. This letter, written by Paul differs from all of his others. We will discuss how this is different. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available.

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. This week the topic is on the *Tragedy in West Texas*. The small town of West, TX was devastated when a fertilizer plant exploded on April 17<sup>th</sup>. Many questions and issues are emerging as survivors grapple with their loss. How can churches offer support and nurture to the community?

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3**. Marshall Martin is away on international travel. The class will resume on May 26 when he returns from Argentina and continue throughout the summer.

**Fresh Faith...** How do you handle your most stressful days? Is your first thought to ask God for help? How about on your best days? Do you share your joy with God? Prayer is the focus of this **Fresh Faith** class. We are going to read and discuss the classic, *Too Busy Not to Pray* by Bill Hybels. Hope you aren't too busy to join us in **the Intersection**.
