## WE DEPART TO SERVE

### Refer, Refer, Refer

There are some odd stories in the Old Testament and the story of Naaman and Elisha is certainly one of them. A powerful foreign general wants healing and a curmudgeonly prophet from Israel prescribes an odd remedy. But one of the notable miracles of the Bible takes place only because someone behind the scenes was not shy about making a perfectly natural referral.

How might we better learn to point people with problems to effective solutions? And how might a perfectly natural referral bring the people we know best closer to God? That's what Pastor Tim will explore in this morning's message.

## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

**Know and Grow...** This class is studying the book of Romans. This letter, written by Paul differs from all of his others. We will discuss how this is different. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available.

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. This week the topic is on the *Tragedy in Bangladesh*. The recent tragic collapse of a garment factory building in Bangladesh prompted renewed scrutiny of the international clothing industry. What issues confront the people who make, sell, and buy apparel in a global economy? What faithful choices can Christians make in response to these issues?

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study series on the life of Paul entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*. This study meets in **Adult Classroom 3** and will continue throughout the summer.
