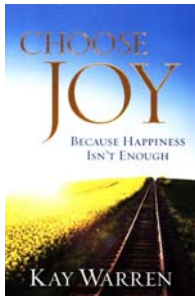
Fellowship Ministries is planning a special celebration just for men! Men of all ages (boys too!) are invited to this special event to honor them. You do not need to

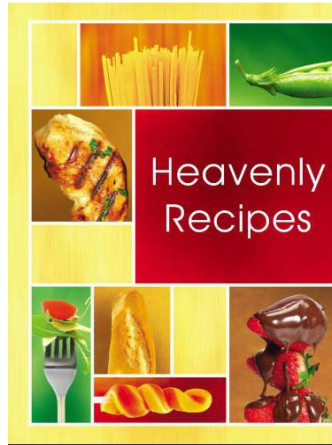
