



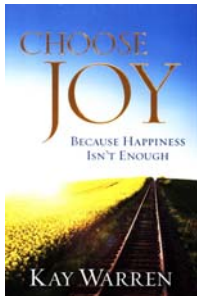
## Get Your Hawaiian Shirts On! Men's Luau! Food, Games, and Lots of Fun! June 28 at 6 p.m.
