Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at 10:00 a.m. Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes include:

Know and Grow... This class is studying Women of the Old Testament. We are using a book titled *A Faith of Her Own* by J. Ellsworth Kalas. We will learn about, and from them; including their defining characteristics, how they fit into, as well as shaped, the Old Testament story. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available.

Christian Issues... This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. This week the topic is on *Daily Spiritual Practice*. Christians often feel too busy or too tired to engage in meaningful spiritual practice in their daily lives. What is spiritual practice? How can we find time and energy in our busy lives to relate more closely to God?

Biblical Foundations of Our Faith... This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3** and will continue throughout the summer.
