## Sunday School Classes

There are Sunday School classes for all ages at **10:00 a.m.** Age appropriate lessons and crafts are planned for the pre-school and elementary age children as well as thought provoking topics and discussions for youth and adults. Adult classes are located in the Education wing and include:

**Know and Grow...** This class is studying Women of the Old Testament. We are using a book titled *A Faith of Her Own* by J. Ellsworth Kalas. We will learn about, and from them; including their defining characteristics, how they fit into, as well as shaped, the Old Testament story. Pick up your Bible and join the Know and Grow class in **Adult Classroom 1**. We have several copies of various translations of the Bible available.

**Christian Issues...** This class meets in **Adult Classroom 2**. They focus on current issues and how they affect our Christian lives. This week the topic is on *Fighting Malaria in Africa*. Every 60 seconds, a child in Africa dies from malaria. What are the successes and continuing challenges in combating this preventable disease? How can Christians support and participate in the ongoing effort to eradicate malaria?

**Biblical Foundations of Our Faith...** This class is doing a multi-month study series entitled: *The Apostle Paul: The Man, the Missionary, and his Ministries*, that will continue through the summer on the life of the Apostle Paul. This study will meet in **Adult Classroom 3** and will continue throughout the summer.
